1. Completion of the above information and Owner acknowledgement (by signature) of Swimming Pool Enclosure Requirements.
2. Site/Plot plan showing pool location with distance to property lines.
3. Before the pool can be used, a Certificate of Occupancy and/or final approval must be obtained from this office.
4. **To obtain a Certificate of Occupancy:**
  - a) All electrical work must meet the NEC, be permitted and performed by a licensed electrical contractor. The Scott County Electrical Inspector must make and approve a rough-in and final electrical inspection.

A final inspection of the pool enclosure (fence) must be conducted and approved by this office.

## Swimming Pool Enclosure Requirements

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**In-ground swimming pool shall be surrounded by a barrier which shall comply with the following:**

1. The top of the barrier shall be at least 48 inches above grade measured on the side of the barrier which faces away from the swimming pool. The maximum vertical clearance between grade and the bottom of the barrier shall be 4 inches measured on the side of the barrier which faces away from the swimming pool.
2. Openings in the barrier shall not allow passage of a 4 inch diameter sphere.
3. Solid Barriers which do not have openings, such as a masonry or stone wall, shall not contain indentations or protrusions except for normal construction tolerances and tooled masonry joints.
4. Where the barrier is composed of horizontal and vertical members and the distance between the tops of the horizontal members is less than 24 inches, the horizontal members shall be located on the swimming pool side of the fence. Spacing between vertical members shall not exceed 1  $\frac{3}{4}$  inches in width. Where there are decorative cutouts within vertical members, spacing within the cutouts shall not exceed 1  $\frac{3}{4}$  inches in width.
  - a. Exception: When intermediate horizontal members are located 34 inches or more above grade, the spacing between vertical members shall not exceed 4 inches in width.
5. Where the barrier is composed of horizontal and vertical members and the distance between the tops of the horizontal members is 24 inches or more, spacing between vertical members shall not exceed 4 inches. Where there are decorative cutouts within vertical members, spacing within the cutouts shall not exceed 1  $\frac{3}{4}$  inches in width.
6. Maximum mesh size for chain link fences shall be a 2  $\frac{1}{4}$  square unless the fence is provided with slats fastened at the top or the bottom which reduce the openings to not less than 1  $\frac{3}{4}$  inches.
7. Where the barrier is composed of diagonal members, such as a lattice fence, the maximum opening formed by the diagonal members shall not be more than 1  $\frac{3}{4}$  inches.
8. Access gates shall comply with requirements of Section AG105.2, Items 1 through 7, and shall be equipped to accommodate a locking device. Pedestrian access gates shall open outward away from the pool and shall be self-closing and have a self-latching device. Gates other than pedestrian access gates shall have a self-latching device. Where the release mechanism of the self-latching device is located less than 48 inches from the bottom of the gate, the release mechanism and openings shall comply with the following:
  - 8-1. The release mechanism shall be located on the pool side of the gate at least 3 inches below the top of the gate: and
  - 8-2. The gate and barrier shall have no opening larger than  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch within 18 inches of the release mechanism.
